



Policy for Awarding Sporting Colours 2017-

It is important that all pupils see that exceptional performances and excellent attitudes to sports are rewarded

On the assumption the colours have traditionally been done on a sport by sport basis there should still be a general guideline behind how these are awarded so that there is a level of consistency between sports. Therefore, the following is suggested when considering pupils.

Intermediate Colours

As below for Half-Colours but awarded for pupils in years 7-10. (Form: Certificate.)

Half Colours (Awarded to years 11-13. Form: Tie for boys/Pin badge for girls)

Two or more of the following:

- Consistent high level performer for the First team with outstanding attitude
- Outstanding service to the club

Full Colours (First team only. Form: Tie for boys/pin badge for girls)

- Outstanding in performance and attitude.
- Awarded only to Year 13 unless genuinely extraordinary circumstances.

Colours Re-awarded (First team only. Form: Cap for boys/Cravat for girls)

- Outstanding in performance and attitude
- Considered by coaching staff to be one of the best on the circuit

Colours should be a prestigious award which should only be given to those fully deserving, therefore we must ensure that all awards are considered carefully before being presented.
