1. Plan to be there by 9:30am to be able to start the tournament games on time.
2. Teams will compete against every team in their group.
3. Games will be best-of-3 sets (25-25-15).
4. Out of the group games, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Finisher in each group will play to make sure every team gets at least 3 games on the day.
5. 1<sup>st</sup> Place finisher from each group will play together for the 1<sup>st</sup> Place Trophy.
6. 2<sup>nd</sup> Place finisher from each group will play together for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Trophy.
7. Games can be started ahead of schedule if both coaches agree.
8. Rosters – If completed please email rosters to me by Friday at 15:00. Coaches are required to bring a printed roster to the tournament on Saturday morning.

### Other Details

- Snacks, drinks and lunch will be available for purchase from 11:00 to 15:00.
- The school nurse will be on duty. Teams are still advised to bring their own first aid kits.
- Please remind students to bring their own water-bottles. Dispensers will be available.
- TEDA will provide volleyballs for the event.

## SECTION 22 – MS VOLLEYBALL RULES

*FIVB* rules (<http://www.fivb.org/EN/Volleyball/Rules/Rules.htm>) will be applied, except for the following amendments:

1. Matches are best 2 out of 3 sets. The 3<sup>rd</sup> set is to 15 pts (must win by 2 pts).
2. Scoresheets and Line-up cards must to be used in the ISAC Tournament. (4/08)
3. Maximum roster size during the ISAC Tournament is 12 players. **This rule does not apply to U12 teams.**
4. It is recommended that a 4-4-2 warm-up system, controlled by the match officials, be used for all matches—and that this includes separate time on court for each school. (4/11)
5. The Libero Rule will **not** be employed.

6. *Unlimited substitutions are permitted, however the following restriction will apply. In any given set, once Player A has been replaced by Player B, these two players can only replace one another. This means that a maximum of 12 players are permitted to play in each set for each team. When a new set commences, the previously established pairing between Player A and Player B no longer applies. New pairings may be created with the start of each new set.*
7. *The following reduced net height will be used (Boys – 2.24m; Girls – 2.15m)*
8. *Service – a maximum of 5 consecutive serves is permitted per player in **U12 and U13** league and tournament play.*
9. *A volleylite-type ball will be used for **U12 and U13** play.*
10. *U12 Mini-Volleyball Rules (see appendix)*
11. *ISAC Tournament Tie-Break Rules:*
  - a. *Result head to head between tied teams*
  - b. *Set differential head to head between tied teams*
    - i. *Does NOT revert back to "a." if a three-way tie results in three different set differentials.*
    - ii. *When two of three teams remain tied the head to head between the two teams would solve the tie*
  - c. *Point differential head to head between tied teams*
  - d. *Overall point differential during the tournament/group play*
  - e. *Coin Toss by Tournament Director or ISAC Chair (03/15)*

## COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

- \* Remember that young people participate for pleasure and that winning is only part of the fun.
- \* Never ridicule or berate a young player for making a mistake or not coming first.
- \* Be reasonable in your demands on players' time, energy and enthusiasm.
- \* Operate within the rules and spirit of your sport and teach your players to do the same.
- \* Ensure that the time players spend with you is a positive experience. All young people are deserving of equal attention and opportunities.
- \* Avoid overplaying the talented players. The average players need and deserve equal time.
- \* Ensure that equipment and facilities meet safety standards and are appropriate to the age and ability of all the players.
- \* Display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with the sport. This includes opponents, coaches, officials, administrators, the media, parents and spectators. Encourage your players to do the same.

- \* Obtain appropriate qualifications and keep up to date with the latest coaching practices and the principles of growth and development of young people.
- \* Any physical contact with a young person should be appropriate to the situation and necessary for the player's skill development.
- \* Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.

## PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

- \* Remember that your children participate in sport for their enjoyment, not yours.
- \* Encourage your children to participate, do not force them.
- \* Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than on the winning and losing.
- \* Encourage children always to play according to the rules and to settle disagreements without resorting to hostility or violence.
- \* Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- \* Remember that children learn best by example. Appreciate good performances and skillful plays by all participants.
- \* Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- \* Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- \* Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child might not have the opportunity to participate.
- \* Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
